

Confessing Jesus

Sovereign Lord over all of life, we

of Presbyterian and Reformed

error in all its parts and to its
teachings as set forth in the
Heidelberg Catechism, the Belgic
Confession, the Canons of Dordt,
the Westminster Confession of
faith, and the Westminster Larger
and Shorter catechisms.

We regard this basis of
fellowship as warrant for the
establishment of a formal
relationship of the nature of a
council, that is, a fellowship that
enables the Member Churches to
advise, counsel, and cooperate
in various matters with one
another and hold out before each
other the desirability and need for
organic union of churches that
are of like faith and practice.
